Circular

The Teaching faculties of West Bengal Medical Education Service and Medical Officers of West Bengal Health Services, who are not drawing Non practicing allowance (NPA) and opted for private practice, are permitted to engage themselves in private practice under provision of West Bengal Medical Education Service (Terms & Condition of option for engaging in Private Practice) Rules 2006 & 2011 and West Bengal Health Service Rules, 1993.

Now, all such Teaching faculties and Medical Officers are instructed to apply to obtain "No Objection Certificate" for engagement in private practice from the Director of Medical Education or the Director of Health Services, as the case may be, before engaging themselves Private Practice in prescribed format as annexed herewith. They can only engage themselves in Private Practice after obtaining the "No Objection Certificate" from the end of Director of Medical Education or the Director of Health Services, as the case may be, within 20 (Twenty) Km radius area from their place of posting and in no circumstances shall be in a Govt. Premises or in a Govt. Quarters.
